

Concord Eastridge Tapped to Build NIA Research Facility

HAMPTON, Va – Virginia Tech has selected Concord Eastridge to develop a 57,411-square-foot research facility for the National Institute of Aerospace. Completion is penciled for December 2011.

Arlington, Va based Concord Eastridge led the development team in the development submission to Virginia Tech. The team includes VIRTEXCO Corporation as the design/build general contractor. VIRTEXCO's team includes Tymoff + Moss Architects, Landmark Design Group and AECOM.

Virginia Tech is a founding member of the National Institute of Aerospace, which was formed by a consortium of leading research universities, which include Georgia Tech, Hampton University, North Carolina A&T State University, North Carolina State University, the University of Maryland, the University of Virginia, Old Dominion University, the College of William & Mary and the AIAA Foundation.
