A white table cloth luncheon was held in the new ballroom of The Mason Inn at George Mason University campus in Fairfax, Virginia on August 27, 2009. What made this event totally unique is that the new ballroom was completely “open air” without walls as the construction continues on the hotel and conference center scheduled to open mid-2010.

This event was held to celebrate the “topping out” of the hotel tower at The Mason Inn. Susan Eastridge, CEO of Concord Eastridge and developer of the project, hosted the ceremony attended by more than 250 guests which was held to recognize this important construction milestone by the project's general contractor, Balfour Beatty Construction. Jeff Barber along with members of the Gensler design team were also in attendance, Gensler is serving as the project's architect.

Dr. Alan Merten, President of George Mason University told the assembled group that this project “Took my breath away” at the day's event. John Tarpey, President of Balfour Beatty Construction, thanked the construction crew for their quality work and maintaining a safe work environment. Ms. Eastridge invited all of the Development Team, the project's workers and the University staff to sign a commemorative wall panel, which will be incorporated into the final construction of The Mason Inn.

The Mason Inn, a 150 room conference center and hotel is slated to open in the summer of 2010. ARAMARK Conference Center group has been selected to manage the Inn. Concord Eastridge is developing this project in partnership with Balfour Beatty Construction.
